Subject: - Grant of Extended Permission to Government Ayurvedic Medical College, Teh. Akhnoor, Village-Sangani, Jammu-181201 Jammu & Kashmir (Inst. ID AYU0476) with intake capacity of 50 seats (63 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26-reg.

Sir/Madam,

- 1) To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely Government Ayurvedic Medical College, Teh. Akhnoor, Village- Sangani, Jammu-181201 Jammu & Kashmir (Inst. ID AYU0476) inspection was conducted on 21.07.2025 and 22.07.2025 on Hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Asessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the permission with intake capacity of 50 seats (63 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26.
- The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the "Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals Regulations, 2024", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations thereunder On careful examination of the assessment report shortcomings/defects were observed and same was communicated to you vide letter of even no. 07.07.2025. In response on the same you have submitted the clarification vide ref. no. GAMC/PS/1066-72 dated 13.08.2025.
- Accordingly, the submitted clarification and the assessment report was once again carefully examined in terms of concerned Acts & Regulations and provision under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, and after verification observation the assessment report was duly placed in the 141th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) convened on 14.08.2025 and Board concluded that the college is fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of permission as per the Concerned Acts and regulations. Hence, the Board decided to issue extended permission with intake capacity of 50 seats (63 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) Course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic year 2025-26 as the college has been permitted consecutively for previous three years after fulfilling the conditions as specified in the concerned Regulations.

"DECISION"

- 4) Therefore, Extended permission in accordance with Regulation 54 (2) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 is hereby granted to Government Ayurvedic Medical College, The.Akhnoor, Village- Sangani, Jammu-181201 Jammu & Kashmir (Inst. ID AYU0476) with an intake capacity of 50 seats (63 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2025-26, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that aforementioned shortcoming shall be fulfilled along with the following conditions:-
 - Minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 50 seats (63 seats I. including EWS) shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
- 5) Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.

- 6) Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.
- Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 8) Compliance of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters vide. ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS. Dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.
- 9) The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report must reach the Board by 31st December, 2025 to be considered for the issuance of permission for the academic session 2026-2027:
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
- 10) The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2026-27.
